ISMS AND NSF: SOME HISTORY AND A LOOK FORWARD

The two organizations have many confluences, and support from the NSF has enabled the research of many ISMS contributors. From the perspective of a former leader of the Mathematical and Physical Sciences Directorate of NSF (2013-2017) and a former Chief Operating Officer of NSF (2018-2021), I will discuss some of that history, the current state, and speculate on the future.
